

# COVID-19 COMMUNITY GRANT

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## BRIEF DESCRIPTION

The COVID-19 Community Grant provides funding for ground-up community projects that are aimed at COVID-19-related assistance to help the community.



### What should the proposal address?

- Projects which supports immediate and direct needs in the Singapore Indian community in COVID pandemic
- Value add to the community and national efforts to tackle the ongoing efforts
- Creating or enhancing new community programmes specific to the pandemic response

### Type of Funding - depending on type of support

- Project Support
  - These grants are restricted to a specific piece of work that provides a direct benefit to the Singapore Indian community to achieve measurable results.
- Core Operating/General Support/Capacity Building Support:
  - This type of support is generally awarded for activities that strengthen an organisation or a common group of organisations, to better achieve its mission for rendering assistance during the pandemic.
- This funding will available for application until the Singapore Government has declared a COVID-19 free environment.



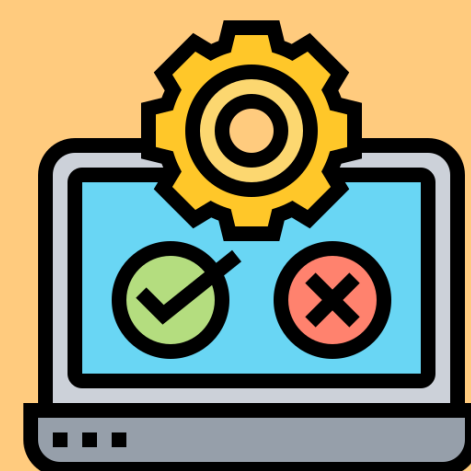
## Funding Amount

- You will receive up to 50% of the actual project cost or \$5,000, whichever is lower. The remaining amount will be given after the project has been completed and approved.

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## ELIGIBILITY & CRITERIA

- Any individual (Singaporean or Singapore Permanent Resident) or a group of individuals or Singapore-based incorporation, including non-profit and community organisations
- The Applicant should be 18 years of age or above.
- The project should commence within one month from date of approval, and be completed within 12 months from the date of approval or end of COVID-19, whichever is earlier.



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## APPLICATION DETAILS & PROCESS

- All applications are subject to SINDA's approval. Grants, if given, are subject to terms and conditions. SINDA reserves the right to change the criteria and terms and conditions of the grant without prior notice.
- After the grant team has clarified the project details with you, the outcome will be shared within **five working days**. Please note that all successful/unsuccessful applications will be notified via email.
- Grant will be given via bank transfer **10-12 working days** after the Grant Agreement Form has been signed.
- Grantees are required to submit a short report with proof of expenditure (i.e. receipts and invoices) **within two weeks** after the project has been completed.
- A mid-term progress report is required if the project period exceeds six months.
